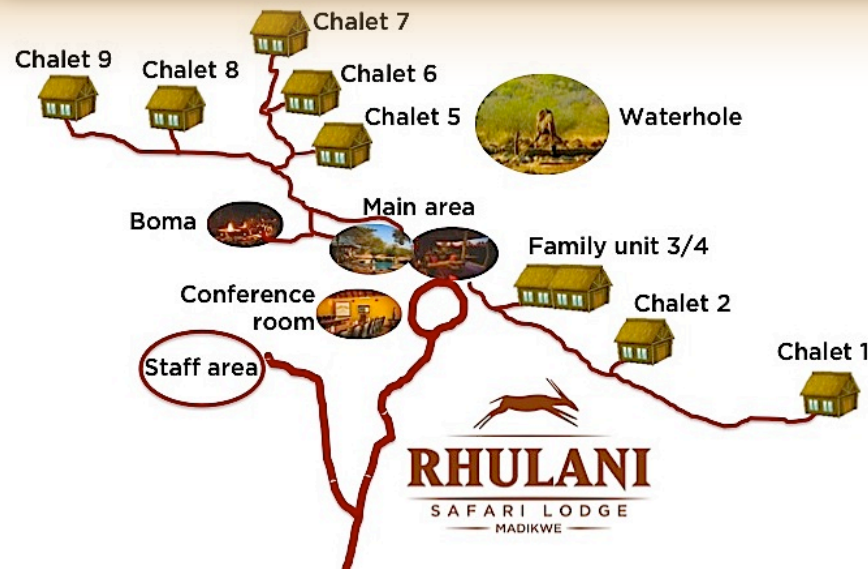

Children policy

- Children of all ages are welcome at Rhulani
- Children from 0 to 5 years stay free of charge
 - Children from 6 to 15 years pay 50% of the per person adult rate
 - Children 16 years and older pay the full adult rate when in their own chalet
 - Children under 12 are permitted on safari at the sole discretion of the field guide
 - Children under the age of 6 are not permitted on safari

- Climate control air-conditioning

- Private deck with 2 deck chairs (uninterrupted views of the Madikwe Game Reserve) and private plunge pool

- Separate entrance doors to suites from the lounge

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Getting there

By road from Johannesburg

- From Johannesburg: head north on the N1 towards Polokwane and the N4/From OR Tambo Int'l Airport: exit the airport and follow R21 towards Pretoria, connect onto N1 towards Polokwane and the N4
- Take the N4 north-west towards Rustenburg, Swartruggens, Groot Marico and Zeerust
- Once in Zeerust, turn right at the third stop street into President Street - there is a signpost on the left that says "Madikwe Game Reserve/ Gaborone" and an Absa Bank branch on the corner to the left
- Follow the R49/47 towards the reserve for approximately 95km
- The first entrance to the reserve is Abjaterskop Gate - pass that gate and enter at the next gate - Wonderboom Gate 7km from the first gate
- Travelling time: approximately four-and-a-half to five hours

Air transfers from Johannesburg

- Air transfers are available daily between OR Tambo Int'l Airport and Madikwe. Flights depart ORTIA at 12h00 and arrive at Madikwe air strip at 12h45. Return flight departs from Madikwe at 13h15 and arrives at ORTIA at 14h00
- Luggage is limited to 20kg per person in soft bags. Other flight times are available seasonally; please contact Rhulani for arrangements and costs. Options are also available via Sun City
- While this service is arranged by Rhulani, it is provided by an independent charter company whose terms and conditions may change without notice
- Guests arriving by plane will be picked up by Rhulani at the airstrip at no additional cost. Please alert our front of house at the time of your reservation



Activities

Tipping standards

- Any gratuities are much appreciated. Cash tips are normally given in South African rand (ZAR) or American dollars (USD), Rhulani also accepts tipping payments by credit card.
- Rangers are tipped separately; minimum industry standard is ZAR125 (or USD10) per guest per day in a shared vehicle
- Other staff: ZAR125 (or USD10) per guest per day
